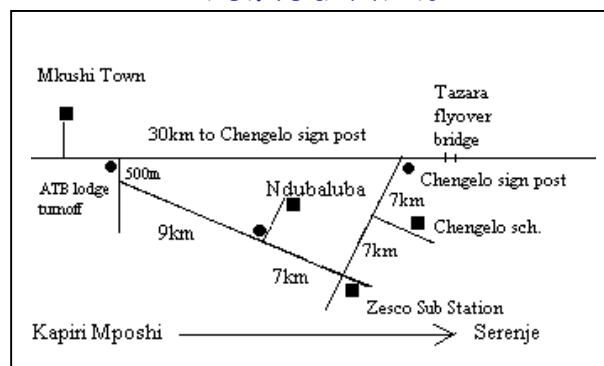


## STAFF SAFETY AND SITE

## THE VISION

Ndubaluba was established by Chengelo School in 1994. It is located 15km from Chengelo School close to the Mwendafye Hills in beautiful Miombo woodlands. Since its inception, the Centre has been leading the way in Adventure Education in Zambia. It provides an Outdoor Education curriculum for Chengelo School and a range of courses for other Zambian Schools, Organizations and Groups from overseas. Over a thousand young people currently pass through the Centre each year.



The Centre aims to provide quality Christian Adventure Education to impact the Nation of Zambia and beyond. ## COURSES

### Chengelo Adventure Curriculum

We provide a school programme with progression of spiritual, mental, emotional and physical Challenges from Pre-School through to 'A' Level. Our whole range of adventure and outdoor activities are used to maximum effect.



### International Youth Award (IYA)

This is a highly esteemed and internationally recognized award for young people. It has 3 different levels, Bronze, Silver and Gold. The award includes community service, sports, skills and a major expedition or exploration. The Centre offers courses, information, advice and training for leaders.



**Leadership Training / Team Building** specifically highlights team dynamics and leadership qualities.

**Expeditions & Community Service** is designed mainly for overseas groups, combining service in the local community with mountain expeditions into the bush.

**Spiritual Development Courses** are specifically for Christian groups to grow, Challenge and develop their faith.



### Adventure Racing

In promoting adventure racing we host the Zambia Adventure Trials and compete internationally with the Chengelo School Adventure Race Team.
